

EBB Statement on the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) Compliance

The EUDR replaces the EU Timber Regulation (EUTR) and extends mandatory due diligence requirements to new commodities as well as stating that businesses must prove that their products do not contribute to deforestation.

EBB is aware of the obligations set out in the EUDR. During the transition period, we will continue to follow the EUTR and UKTR regulations whilst taking the necessary measures to ensure that we are prepared and compliant with the EUDR.

Any UK business which trade with EU members will need to adapt to the EUDR. The European Commissions have stated that Northern Ireland will be included with EUDR not UKTR. Any businesses trading solely within the UK will only be obliged to follow the UKTR.

EBB is engaged with our supply chain to ensure that everyone is working towards compliance to the regulation by the 30th December 2024.
